Pumpkins have been the protagonists of our curriculum this week. After reading the book, "From Seed to Pumpkin, by Wendy Pfeffer and James Graham Hale and after watching a video

related to the life cycle of pumpkins, we have reproduced a pumpkin path in our classroom. The children have added the pumpkins you have sent from home to our pretend soil and completed the scene with leaves, vines and paper seeds. Please, have your child bring in his/her own pumpkin if you have not yet done so. We are trying to collect as many different shapes, colors and sizes and textures- there are so many out there. It makes them very proud to hold their special gift for the class at meeting time.

The children have painted pumpkins at the easel and drawn beautiful pumpkin patches with tempera crayons and printed pumpkins with yellow, green, orange and white paint.

We have also talked about what type of food we can make with pumpkins, like muffins, pies, soup, cookies and how you can roast the seeds in the oven. YUM!
