- I sent a reminder home earlier this week about mask wearing policy. NYC reconsidered their dropping the mask mandate for preschool. We had already said we will continue with the masks through June. We are

I visited 2 of them to talk about this natural process, connecting it to the conversations they

have been all having about life cycle, how you know when something is alive, what are the conditions a living thing must have to survive. I read The Dead Bird, where a group of children find a dead bird on the ground. They bury it in



the woods. I did not add that part, just that they put out flowers and sang about the bird in memory. And then they went back to their playing. Very matter-of-fact. While we try hard to protect the eggs- and our kids- losing some is part of what makes this curriculum so important
